The Member Secretary and Principal welcomed the Chairman and the members for the Governing Council meeting.

In the opening remarks, Chairman announced that NMAMIT is getting into the fold of Nitte University (NU) from 2022-23 and NU is preparing to conduct entrance examinations, finalizing the fee details and scholarships. He said that 20% seats shall be allotted based on merit scholarship and in the remaining 80%, maximum 5% seats shall be given on concession fee to the children of our employees on inter-se merit amongst them. The overall fees will be reduced for every branch under NU. He also shared a thought of starting a new UG and two PG programs during 2022-23 under NU. Chairman advised the Principal to coordinate with NMIT Bangalore for strengthening the syllabus and knowledge sharing.

Principal presented the latest achievements of NMAMIT under which he presented the details of sponsored projects, patents, publications etc... Dr. Bhamy Shenoy, GC Special Invitee, sought details about the numbers and amount sanctioned to the Projects in the previous year. Principal presented the details and mentioned that as NMAMIT joins the Nitte Deemed to be University, the faculty could apply for more Interdisciplinary projects. Due to the fact that NMAMIT will be part of the University (and not an affiliated college of the University), chances of getting better external funding will be

high . Chairman advised the Principal to form a committee to monitor the quality of sponsored projects and to arrange for specific programs to encourage faculty members to apply for more sponsored projects. Dr. Bhamy Shenoy suggested to conduct a few National level technical competitions for students to enhance the image of the Institute .

Dr. Mrityunjaya V.Latte- VTU Nominee of GC mentioned that the amount spent on Research facilities and equipment require to be increased. The total number of publications are good but the publications under Web of Science should improve. PG programs and Research activities should be complementing to each other. An appeal must be given to the alumni to provide scholarships and support for Incubation facility for the deserving students.

With this awareness of skill labs, students can select any one skill area and can take up a project in the subsequent years.

Note: Member Secretary informed about new VTU guidelines about the 3 weeks' Internship at the end of first year. This internship activity has been started in the Institute right from the first semester where there will be a faculty mentor for every 5 students to guide till their III semester. These faculty members will also act as teacher guardians for their group of students.

Note: Member secretary informed that since M.Tech (Electric Vehicle Technology) course is not listed in the AICTE approved course list, a request has been sent to AICTE to include the same. A detailed curriculum also has been prepared by the Electrical Engg. Department and has been sent to AICTE. Faculty members in EEE department have good expertise in this field and the department has a MODROBS funded Electric Vehicle lab. Two electric vehicles have been designed and developed in the department so far. Dr. Gopal Mugeraya suggested to approach some good companies requesting to help the M.Tech students for internships and employment. The matter was placed before Governing Council for information and approval.

GC/55-05/22: Research Promotion policy

Member Secretary presented the modified Research Promotion Policy. GC members enquired about the academic and administrative audit. Member Secretary informed that during last 4 years (except the previous year) every year the Academic and administrative audit was conducted. Sri Gopinath, being one of the members of previous two academic and administrative audit teams, explained the details of the audits conducted. Dr. Gopal Mugeraya informed that he can assist in providing academic and administration audit formats from NIT. Dr. Moodithaya said that once NMAMIT joins the Nitte (Deemed to be University) the best practices followed in the University with regards to Academic and Administrative audit will be extended to NMAMIT.

Member Secretary presented the purpose and the constitution of Research Ethics committee and Research Advisory Committee. Dr. Mrityunjaya V Latte suggested to have one member from outside the Institute in the Research Ethics Committee.

The matter was placed before Governing Council for ratification and approval.

GC/55-06/22: Applying for NBA and NAAC Re-accreditation and applying for NIRF 2022

Member Secretary informed the GC that since the validity of present NBA accreditation is expiring in June 2022, already the compliance report for the extension of NBA accreditation has been sent to NBA along with requisite fee.

Dr. Moodithaya said that once NMAMIT joins Nitte (Deemed to be) University the NAAC Grade of Nitte University will be applicable for NMAMIT automatically.

GC/55-07/22: Balance Sheet of 2020-21

Note: Member Secretary presented the audited Balance sheet of 2020-21 and provided details about Income and Expenditure. Sri. Rajendra, Finance Director informed the GC that during 2020-21 due to COVID pandemic not many activities could take place in the Institute and thus the surplus was about Rs.20 crores. However, the construction activity has been going on and about Rs.15 to Rs.16 crores have been spent on this from the surplus available.

Dr. Gopal Mugeraya asked the Institute to apply for more FIST like projects and get more research funds.

Chairman advised to look into upgradation of department lab equipments. Member Secretary replied that all Civil and E&E equipment are already upgraded when they were moved to the new academic block. The Mechanical Engineering department equipment are getting upgraded as and when required. The lab equipment of Biotechnology department is now getting upgraded - he said.

Dr. Bhamy Shenoy asked about getting assistance from Alumni to create Endowment fund and asked whether it will create any problems . Sri. Rajendra said that already there are some endowment funds created by alumni for giving the prize money every year and there are no problems in having such endowment funds.
