Reimbursement of publication charges

1. Reimbursement may be claimed subject to following conditions:

- a. Journal is currently indexed in Scopus and / or Web of Science core indices and ranked Q2 or higher within the primary category of the topic of the publication. Rankings of the latest available year will be considered.
- b. Reimbursement can be claimed only by Nitte DU faculty members who are first or corresponding authors.

2. Following types of publications are eligible:

- c. Article
- d. Review / Meta-analysis
- e. Case report

3. Following types of publications are not eligible:

- f. Abstract
- g. Conference proceedings / Conference reports
- h. Editorial
- i. Erratum
- j. Letter
- k. Note
- I. Press release
- m. Short Survey
- 4. For publications arising from externally funded projects, reimbursement of publication charges may be claimed from the contingency and / or overheads grants of the projects
- 5. Proportionate share of authors from institutions outside of Nitte DU who are not from organization with formal collaborations / MOUs with Nitte DU will be deducted from the eligible amount.

7. Procedure to apply for publication fee reimbursement

- a. The faculty should have sought for partial/full waiver from the Editor/Journals (Correspondence for the same to be enclosed)
- b. In case of a journal having an 'Open Access' option, authors are requested to go with 'Closed Access' in the same journal.
- c. The manuscript, journal details, indexing and Q ranking should be submitted to the University when requesting for fee assistance.
